Kodak Manual Feeder / for i600 Series Scanners

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The Kodak Manual Feeder / for i600 Series Scanners provides a flat work surface to aid in manual feeding.

This document provides instructions on how to install and use the manual feeder.

Installing and using the Manual Feeder

Before installing the manual feeder the elevator tray must be in the lowest position (500 Sheets).

1. Open the side guides on the scanner to the widest position.



2. Place the manual feeder on top of the elevator tray using the slots in the manual feeder to align with the side guides. Position the manual feeder to the fully seated position.



The manual feeder has two locations for the side guides. Depending on the size of the documents you are scanning:

- use the holes closest to the center of the manual feeder if you are scanning documents smaller than 21.59 cm (8.5 in.).
- use the holes farthest away from the center of the manual feeder if you are scanning documents larger than 21.59 cm (8.5 in.).

3. After inserting the manual feeder, install the side guides. Align the holes on the manual feeder with the pegs on the left side guide as shown.



- 4. When the left side guide is in place, insert the right side guide in the same manner.
- 5. Adjust the side guides to the desired position by sliding them in or out to accommodate the size of the documents you are scanning.



6. Tighten the screws on both side guides to secure them in place.



- 7. Raise the elevator tray to the highest position (ADF) to secure the manual feed tray.
- 8. Scan the document(s) in single-sheet or hand-held position.

Removing the manual feeder

- 1. Lower the elevator tray to its lowest position (500 Sheets).
- 2. Remove the manual feeder.



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
