Upgrading to Version 6.0.0

Upgrading Stand-Alone Installations

- The customer's Capture Pro Software Serial Number must be entitled to the 6.0 release
 - The Entitlement Date (or Software Assurance Expiration Date) must be March 1, 2022 or later
- To upgrade, download the installer (CapProSW_6_0_0.exe) file from www.alarisworld.com/go/captureprodownload and run it.
 - The installer will automatically upgrade an existing Capture Pro install to Version 6.0.0
 - When upgrading from Version 5.9 or earlier, an Internet connection is required during the upgrade as the KODAK Alaris licensing system will generate a new 6.0 license
 - o If an Internet connection is not available or allowed, the installation wizard will guide you through the off-line process of obtaining (and installing) a license from a PC that does have Internet access



Upgrading to Version 6.0.0 (continued)

Upgrading Network Edition Installations

- Both the NE Server and the NE Client workstations must be upgraded to Version 6.0 at the same time.
 - You cannot run a Version 5.9 client workstation with a Version 6.0 NE Server
 - You cannot run a Version 6.0 client workstation with a Version 5.9 NE Server
- To upgrade, download the installer files from www.alarisworld.com/go/capturepronedownload and run them
 - IIS on the Network Edition Server must be STOPPED prior to the upgrade and RESTARTED after the upgrade



Upgrading to Version 6.0.0 (continued)

- Q: Can a Subscription customer upgrade to Version 6.0?
- A: Yes. Subscription customers are entitled to new releases that come out during their Subscription timeframe.
 - Prior to upgrading to Version 6.0, the Subscription customer should contact Service and Support with their Hardware ID and their intention to upgrade.
 - A new Version 6.0 Subscription license, with the same Group level and Expiration Date, will be created for the customer's Hardware ID.
 - Service and Support will then contact the customer indicating that their Version 6.0 subscription license is ready, and that the customer can now upgrade to Version 6.0.

Update Outdated Libraries

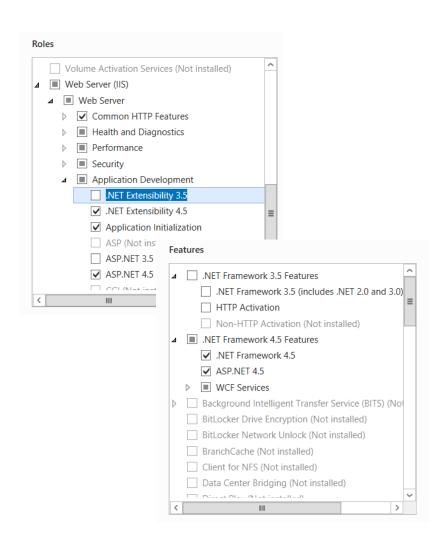
- Includes replacement of Microsoft libraries and library versions that are no longer supported
- The OCR and bar code engine libraries have been updated to the latest version available

Remove dependency of .NET Framework 3.5

- No longer required to be installed or activated on scanning/indexing workstations
- No longer required when installing the License Manager
- Server Roles and Features related to .NET 3.5 no longer need to be installed on server running the NE Server

Full support for TLS 1.2

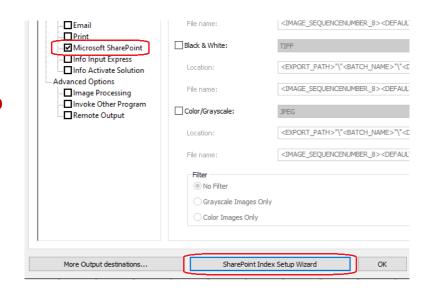
 As IT departments are deprecating support for TLS 1.0 and 1.1, this support becomes necessary for Capture Pro and Capture Pro Network Edition



New Features

SharePoint Online Modern Authentication

- IT organizations are deprecating support for Basic or Legacy authentication
- Modern Authentication encompasses methods such as MFA (Multi-Factor Authentication)
- Only available through the SharePoint Index Setup Wizard
 - As a result, Modern Authentication support is currently <u>not available in Capture Pro Limited</u> Edition



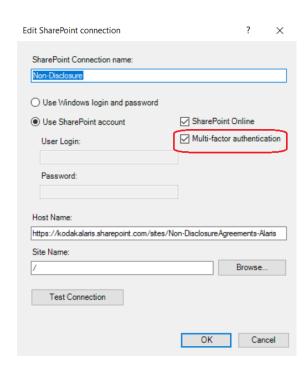


SharePoint Online Modern Authentication (continued)

- When enabled, no user credentials are required if the user who logged onto the PC is a domain user on the company network
 - When the first batch is output, after launching Capture Pro, the user may see a taskbar pop-up that will go away on its own



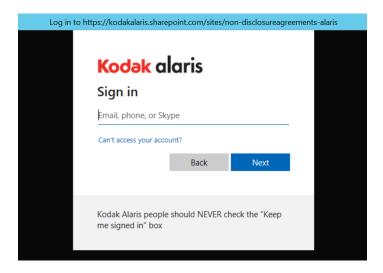
 During this activity, Capture Pro is getting a Token that can be re-used for all subsequent batch output processing for that Capture Pro login session

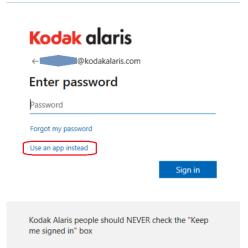




SharePoint Online Modern Authentication (continued)

• If the user who logged onto the PC is not a domain user on the company network, then the user will be required to authenticate when processing the first batch after launching Capture Pro. For example:



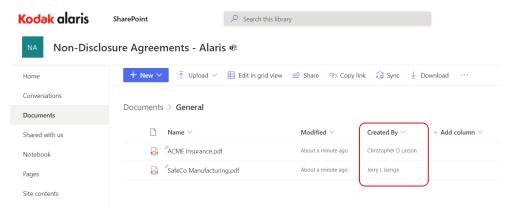






SharePoint Online Modern Authentication (continued)

 With this new feature, the Windows user who outputs the batch will get reflected in the document entry in the SharePoint Document Library

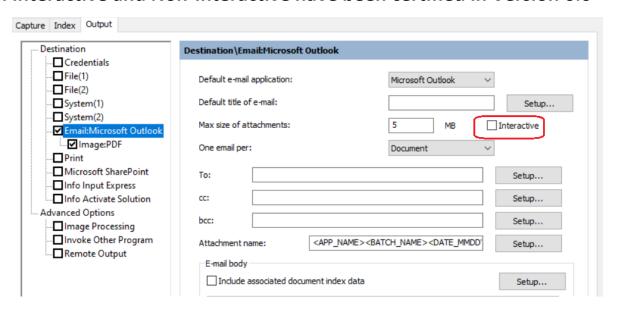


 In previous Capture Pro versions, which only supported Basic/Legacy authentication, it was the <u>user credentials entered in Job Setup</u> that got "credit" for creating the document in SharePoint



email Output with 64-bit Version of Microsoft Outlook

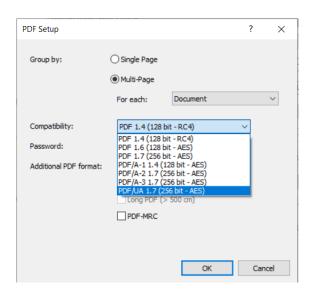
- email output only worked with Outlook 32-bit in previous releases

PDF/UA (Universal Accessibility) Output

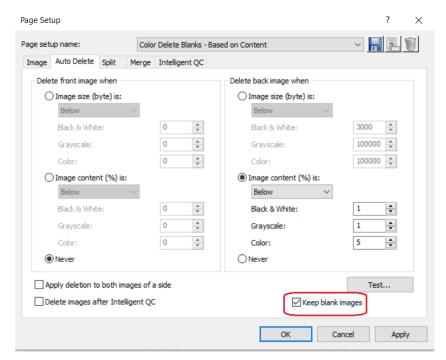
 Conformance with PDF/UA ensures accessibility for people with disabilities who use assistive technology to navigate and read electronic content





Mark Images for Deletion

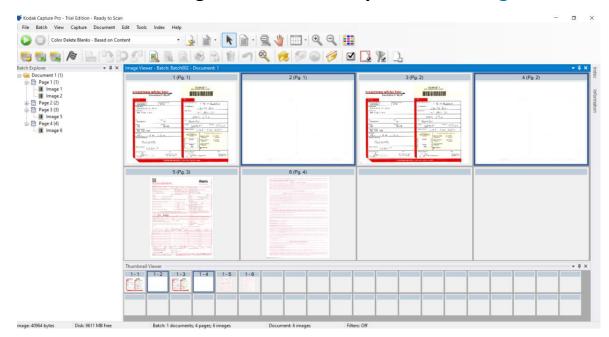
- Allows BPOs, Service Bureaus, and other organizations who are often legally required to keep every image scanned, to identify blank images (and other images that should normally be deleted) and deliver the "marked for deletion" status to their customers

Mark Images for Deletion (continued)

• Marked as Blank images are identified by a Blue Rectangle



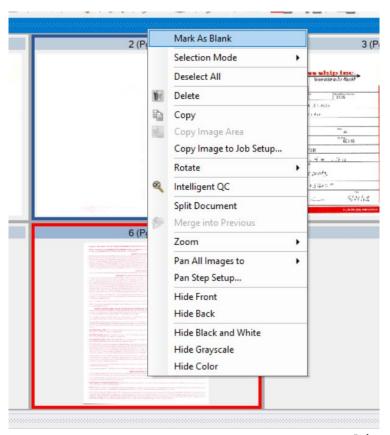


Mark Images for Deletion (continued)

 The Marked as Blank status can be toggled by the user via a right-click menu option

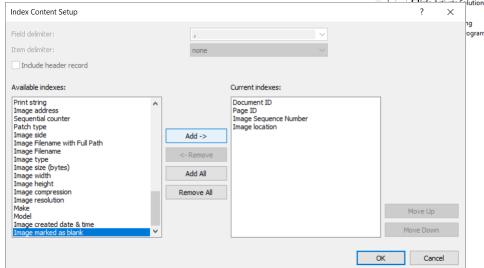
- This toggle option is only available when the selected Page Setup has the "Keep blank images" option enabled

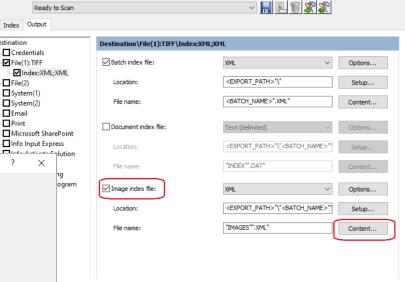

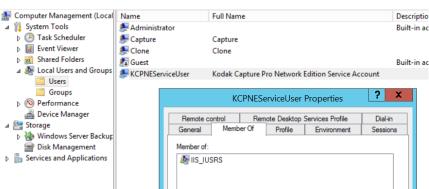
Network Edition Changes

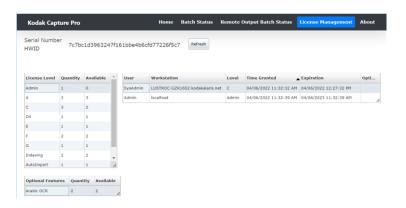
Removed Silverlight Dependency for NE Dashboard

- Silverlight is obsolete technology that is no longer supported by Microsoft
- The NE Dashboard can now run in any browser

Allow KCPNEServiceUser to be removed from Administrators Group

 KCPNEServiceUser is still required but is now part of the IIS_IUSRS group







Problems Fixed in 6.0.0

- Improved output of large sPDF output files (i.e., sPDFs with a large number of images)
 - Up to 500 pages (or 1000 images), A4 or Letter, scanned at 300 DPI color, gray, or bitonal is officially supported
 - O Your results may vary depending on DPI, image type, image size, and image content
 - Amount of free disk space on the C: drive of the PC may also impact the results as every image in the document will be uncompressed to the user's TEMP directory on the PC before being combined into the output PDF
 - For example, outputting a batch containing a 1000 image (letter size) document scanned at 300 DPI Color would require between 12 and 14GB of free disk space in order to process successfully
- Unable to output documents to a 2-level folder structure in SharePoint Online.
- Capture Pro crashing when auto importing large format documents with Data Matrix bar code separation enabled
- Capture Pro intermittently crashing in mfc140u.dll when rescanning pages that caused a multifeed (configured for continuous scanning)



Problems Fixed in 6.0.0 (continued)

- Version 5.8 and 5.9 do not properly display Help->Index Tab results for Japanese, Chinese,
 Korean, Russian, and Arabic languages
- Dutch Translations of Auto Restart Feature were in Swedish language
- Batch Counter not being updated with Daily Counter Reset and Quick Start View Network Edition
- Scanner Counter not getting reset to specified value when using Daily Counter Reset and the Quick Start or Scanner Button is used to start scanning on a new day.
- Capture Pro crashing attempting to output batches with a large amount of index data to an output index file.
 - The amount of index data that can be output to a single index file has been increased to 1GB.



Problems Fixed in 6.0.0 (continued)

- Capture Pro does not output 600 or 1200 DPI PDF documents for PDF/A, PDF-MRC, or sPDF.
 - Images were being downscaled to 300 DPI in the output PDF.
- Searchable text not being produced in output PDF files containing large format drawing images with the OCR Accuracy set to the More Accurate setting
- DB Switcher Program Does Not Correctly Update Connection String When Only TLS 1.2 is Enabled
